The Chatham Islands Resource Management Document 2001 permits the erection or placement of general structures in Coastal Marine Areas. The placement of Mooring anchor blocks are a permitted activity under this document. Part 5.6 of the Chatham Islands Navigation Safety Bylaw 2005 sets out the 'Entitlement to lay and use a Swing Mooring' and is overseen by the Regional Harbourmaster. Chatham Islands Navigation Safety Bylaws 2005 - Part 5

5.6 Entitlement to lay and use a Swing Mooring

- (1) No person shall lay a swing mooring unless:
 - (a) the mooring occupies a position that has been allocated by the Regional Harbourmaster
 - (b) the mooring has been allocated a unique number by the Regional Harbourmaster
 - (c) the swing mooring and its fittings meet any specifications and conditions set by the Regional Harbourmaster;
 - (d) the owner of the swing mooring has paid the annual fee specified in Schedule 3; and
 - (e) all necessary consents required under the Resource Management Act have been obtained.

- (2) No person shall tie a vessel to or moor a vessel on a swing mooring unless:
 - (a) the Regional Harbourmaster has authorised the use of the swing mooring for mooring that vessel or size of vessel; and
 - (b) that the owner of the swing mooring has paid the annual swing mooring Registration Fee specified in Schedule 3.

- (3) No person shall reassign or transfer the ownership of a swing mooring without the approval of the Regional Harbourmaster.

- (4) No person shall tie a vessel to or moor a vessel on a swing mooring whose ownership has been reassigned or transferred unless:
 - (a) the approval of the Regional Harbourmaster has been obtained; and
 - (b) the change of ownership fee specified in Schedule 3 has been paid by the previous owner of the swing mooring.
