Areas of Significant Natural Values

Areas of significant natural values include:

- areas of significant indigenous vegetation and habitats of fauna
- outstanding natural features and landscapes

The areas generally consist of land managed by the Department of Conservation and Council, private lands protected by conservation covenants/kawenta and Nga Whenua Rahu and areas in the coastal marine area and areas on private land which the landowner has agreed to. Some areas do not have public access and enquiries should be made with the landowners.

All of the areas meet the criteria specified in Part 4.4.2 and 4.5.2 of the document.
